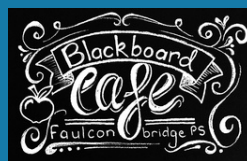

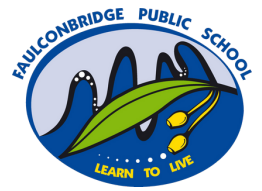
## Blackboard Cafe Returns on Fridays for Parents, Students and Teachers!
